

BUYING A DEVELOPED DIGITAL PROPERTY

A clear path from inquiry to ownership.

A useful name. The work behind it. An agreed handover into accounts you control.

01 Review the exact asset inventory

Confirm the domain and any expressly included companion domains; the specified website source, original content and tools; and the available technical documentation. Third-party materials remain subject to their licenses. Only the seller's transferable rights are offered.

02 Inspect the evidence

Review the current demonstration, source files, licenses, known issues, email test results, and operating costs. Request support for any traffic, revenue, customer, or performance claim. None is implied by a listing or by the existence of a working website.

03 Agree the scope and transaction process

Record the included assets, exclusions, price, responsibilities, timing, and acceptance checks in written owner-approved terms. Select a mutually acceptable escrow process before moving funds or assets.

04 Transfer, verify, and accept

Follow the agreed escrow instructions. Transfer the specified domains and files, establish buyer-controlled services, replace credentials, and verify the website and email. Release funds and close the handover under the agreed acceptance terms.

The final asset inventory and written agreement control. This guide is a proposed process, not a binding offer or a promise of included implementation or ongoing support.

EMAIL, OPERATING COSTS & NEXT STEPS

The setup is documented. The next account is yours.

Email is a useful part of the handover, with a separate service, cost, and verification process.

Custom-domain email configuration

The sale-domain setup uses a `contact@` mailbox with `info@`, `sales@`, and `hello@` aliases on the same domain. Aliases deliver to the mailbox; they are not four separate inboxes. Request the configuration record for the exact property, including any named companion domains.

Current status - September 11, 2026: Configuration is recorded, but provider delivery review remains open. Production readiness is not yet confirmed. Request current property-specific test results and unresolved issues during diligence.

Plan the email handover

Establish an account you control, migrate or recreate the agreed addresses, update domain records, and verify receiving, sending, replies, and authentication. Seller assistance and its duration must be agreed in writing. The shared portfolio provider account, unrelated mailboxes, recovery accounts, passwords, and historical correspondence are excluded unless expressly agreed otherwise.

Budget for continued operation

Confirm dated costs for domain renewals, website and email hosting, any licensed services, maintenance, migration, and transaction fees. Provider terms and charges are separate from the purchase. Lifetime email hosting, perpetual website hosting, and guaranteed inbox placement are not offered.

Request the property-specific materials

Email inquiries@webassethouse.com with the domain, intended use, and preferred timing. Ask for the current asset inventory, asking terms, email delivery status, and handover details.
